Use a spud bar as you walk out on ice! Wear ice picks, bring a friend & a rope!

Avoid shallow areas with dark bottom, reeds, and any areas with current during sunny warm conditions

Please use caution when venturing out on early Ice!

NO ATV Travel recommended w/ Inconsistent Ice Conditions

Do NOT venture out over the main bodies of deep lakes!
